Dr. Brij Mohan Mishra, 75, of **Fayetteville**, NY, passed away peacefully on August 4 with his loving family by his side. He graduated from medical school in Jaipur, India, and completed psychiatry training at Upstate Medical University, and then made Syracuse his home.

He was a multitalented man in a myriad of ways. First, Dr. Mishra practiced as a psychiatrist and later, became a successful hotelier. He was gracious, welcoming and always available for others. He once famously hosted a wedding party for a couple he did not know (a "friend of a friend" was all it took!).

Dr. Mishra was highly respected, and a rare leader who earned universal affection. His philanthropy was not just local but visionary and international. He built and endowed a progressive, K12 school in his birthplace, the tiny town of Pilani, India. Why? "Because my mother said I should do it". As in everything he did, he pushed for excellence and the school is highly regarded in that region.

Dr. Mishra **leaves behind** a wife, Dr. Suman, a son, Gautam, and his wife, Mridula, whom he loved and was proud of; and a granddaughter, Anjali, whom he adored.
